



Why Use the New Wheel of Fortune® Game for Training

Looking for a new way to introduce and review key terms and concepts? Wheel of Fortune makes terminology fun by challenging players to solve word puzzles. Players “spin the wheel” to guess letters and solve the puzzle before the time runs out. Additional puzzle types, from toss ups to bonus rounds, allow you to customize the experience to fit your goals and your target audience.



We recommend using Wheel of Fortune to pre-test, pre-teach, present, and practice vocabulary and topics, or measure how much people have learned. Three main characteristics drive engagement:



Uncertainty

Random spins drives replayability, engaging players with a risk/reward choice on each turn.



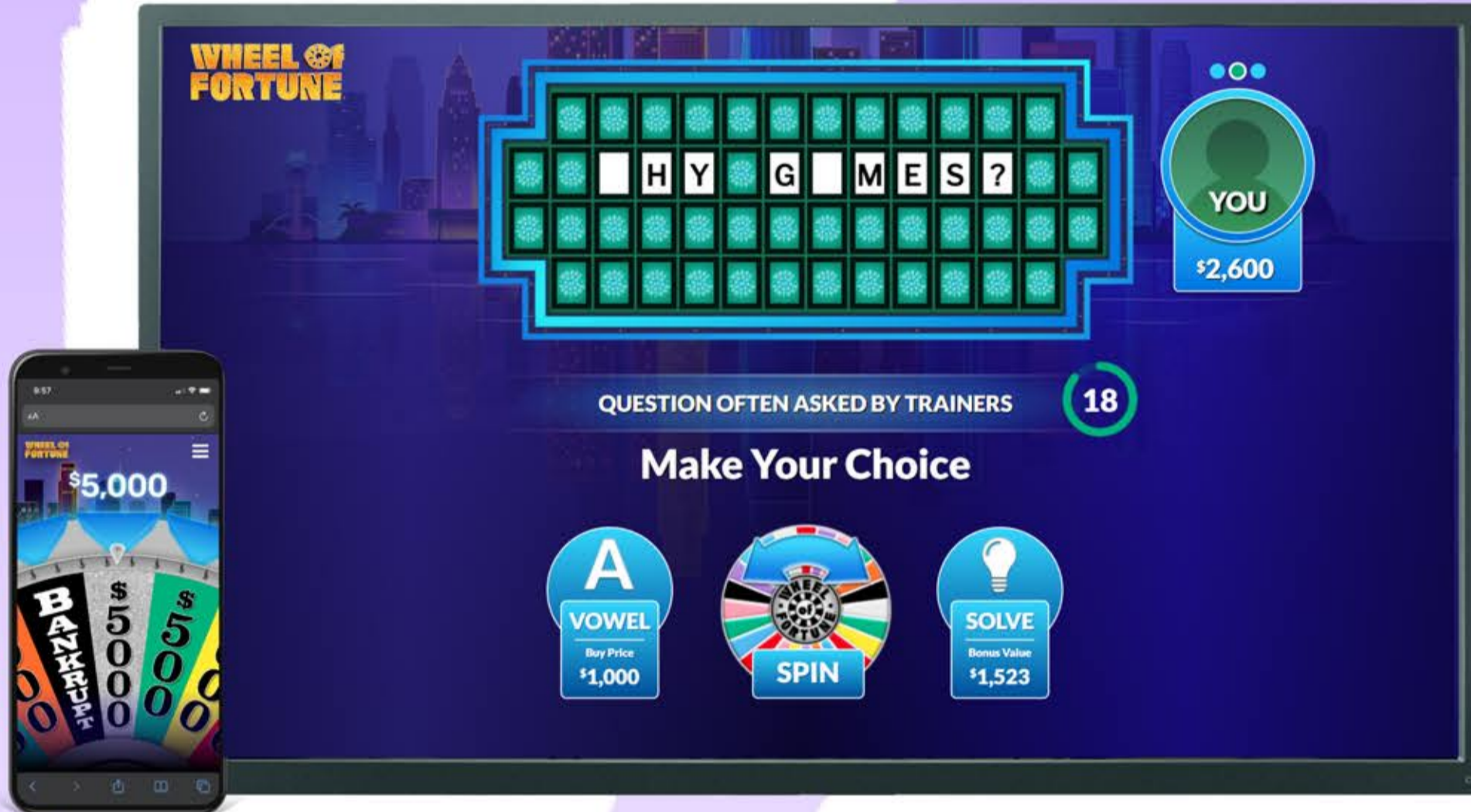
Amount Builds

With earnings adding up, players are challenged to solve the puzzle for the biggest reward.



Anticipation

As letters appear on the puzzle board, the allure that success is within reach holds the player's attention, releasing dopamine that makes them want to play even more.



Produce a Custom Learning Experience

Wheel of Fortune has the most robust Admin tools yet! Craft the ultimate learning experience by controlling the order and types of puzzles. You can insert other learning materials (text, images, or videos) between puzzles or after each other. There are three types of puzzles:

SPIN ROUND

What is it? The classic Wheel of Fortune game. Players spin the wheel for a chance to guess a letter.

How do I use it? Use this to introduce terms and increase engagement with the content. It's fun to take a risk and figure out what letters are in a puzzle, and it's a safe space for players to get familiar with and practice the content before taking a test.

BONUS ROUND

What is it? The Bonus Round starts with a few letters (usually RSTLNE) revealed. You may allow players to select a few additional letters as clues. Players must solve the puzzle before the time is up.

How do I use it? This is another good option for practice or assessment, and this round can provide a different format than Toss Up alone.

TOSS UP

What is it? A puzzle where letters are revealed one-by-one. Players guess the puzzle as soon as they can before all letters are revealed.

How do I use it? This is great for practice or assessment. We recommend using it after a Spin Puzzle, interstitial, or other learning event to see how much learners retained.
